Liturgy Commission (LC): Mass of Remembrance went well. Attendance was up from last year's Mass. Incense will be used at the Christmas Eve 10:30 PM Mass. Adoration will be accessible prior to Mass.

Faith Formation Commission (FFC): Father suggested all children process through church during All Saints Day, wearing costumes or not. The Saint Nicholas Craft Fair was a huge success this year. Next year, a table will be set up with information regarding the Church. David Rinaldi will be guest speaker for the Lenten event. There will be a catered sit-down meal February 23rd. The Mission Trip 2020 will take place in Jacksonville, FL for continued disaster recovery from hurricanes. SPY will host a bake sale December 21 and 22. They are looking for baked goods. Winter blast is scheduled for December 13.

Finance Council (FC): Cindy will be researching refinancing on the loan. She will contact three financial institutions to see what they can offer or the costs involved. The parish is short \$4,597 from meeting the Catholic Services Appeal goal to receive 10% back. Should St. Patrick's pay the difference to receive the \$5,568? The FC will discuss at the December meeting. The FC will have a 45-minute slot at the All Parish Meeting.
