I. Old Business

- A. Opening Prayer – Father Brian led us in prayer.
- B. Commission Liaison Reports:
 - a. **Worship (WC)** – Went through commissions and eliminated 13.
 - b. **Faith Formation (FFC)** – Lots of interest on timeline, Mary Garden dedication in May or June, confirmation will be at parish, butter braid fundraiser still a possibility.
 - c. **Parish Life (PLC)** – Men’s’ Club purchased lawn sweeper, 55+ not meeting, discussed the bottle shop should be sure to separate peanut items for those that have allergies, Fall Festival was successful, food trucks a big hit.
 - d. **Pastoral Care (PCC)** – recruiting members
 - e. **Social Justice (SJC)** – Idea to send cards to shut-ins, Interested in flock notes for commission meetings.
 - f. **Administration (AC)** – Stewardship, reaching out to other parishes, working on definition of commission, reviewed all ministries in this commission, looking to update website
 - g. **Finance (FC)** – The paperwork is completed on PPP loan forgiveness. The November letter to parishioners had positive response. The council is looking into having a second columbarium built. A loan payment was made for December in the amount of \$23,070.45. This is \$7,000 per month less than the previous loan

- E. Timeline Update – Project will fall under PLC with support from the AC. A committee will be established to come up with key milestones of the Parish.
